

Hygiene and safety guidelines for city tours

Applicable to all participants and tour guides

Test/proof requirement, mask requirement and distancing rules

¹ Number of new coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 infections per 100,000 inhabitants in the municipality for the fifth working day in a row according to publications of the Robert Koch Institute.

² A negative test must be provided in order to take part. This must be a PCR test or rapid antigen test no older than 24 hours. Self-tests are not accepted. Children up to the age of 14 are not required to take a test. Those who are fully vaccinated or who have recovered from coronavirus do not need to provide a negative test. Proof of vaccination or recovery from coronavirus (positive PCR test result taken at least 28 days prior and no more than 6 months ago) is sufficient in this case. Guests who are exempted from the test requirement but have symptoms associated with coronavirus must also provide a negative test result.

* Someone is considered fully vaccinated if more than 14 days have passed since he/she received the last vaccine dose that is required for a full vaccination scheme.

³ It is mandatory to wear a medical mask. It does not need to be worn during tasting or at a restaurant table. The term "medical mask" refers to both surgical masks and masks certified to protection classes "KN95/N95" or "FFP2". The mask requirement also applies to people who are fully vaccinated, those who have recovered from coronavirus and individuals with a negative test result (no older than 24 hours).

⁴ A minimum distance of 1.5 metres must be kept from other people. This excludes members of your own household. This also applies to fully vaccinated people, those who have recovered from coronavirus and people with a negative test result.

Collection of contact data

The contact data for one person per household will be collected to be able to perform contact tracing later on.

Group size

The number of people in a group will be adjusted depending on the infection rate.

Tickets

It is no longer possible to purchase tickets from the tour guide on the day. Tickets must be purchased online, in advance, at Tourist Information offices (please note the opening times) or by telephone from the Service Center.

Adhere to coughing and sneezing rules

Cough or sneeze into your elbow, not into your hand.
